The apostle Paul introduced Timothy to Jesus. When Timothy became a pastor, Paul wrote him two letters filled with wise counsel. There is a theme in the letters. Paul tells him, "Fight the good fight." And he gives him directions for how to fight the good fight.

1 Timothy 1:18 NIV

Timothy, my son, I am giving you this command in keeping with the prophecies once made about you, so that by recalling them you may fight the battle well,
