We want to make an organizational chart for every relationship we enter. And we either want our names in the box at the top of the chart. If that's not possible, we want our independence. This drive to supervise and control others, along with it's opposite, the drive to rebel and refuse to allow someone else to control us  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{N}$ these two drives deform our ideas about all our relationships, especially marriage. And do not get drunk with wine, which is debauchery, but be filled by the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making music in your hearts to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for each other in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, and submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ. Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord, because the husband is the head of the wife as also Christ is the head of the church  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{N}$  he himself being the savior of the body. But as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives just as Christ loved the church and gave himself for her to sanctify her by cleansing her with the washing of the water by the word, so that he may present the church to himself as glorious  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{N}$  not having a stain or wrinkle, or any such blemish, but holy and blameless. In the same way husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one has ever hated his own body but he feeds it and takes care of it, just as Christ also does the church, for we are members of his body. For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and will be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. This mystery is great â€" but I am actually speaking with reference to Christ and the church. Nevertheless, each one of you must also love his own wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.

The passage starts with a command for all Jesus followers,  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{R}$  filled by the Spirit. $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{I}$  It $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{M}$ s followed by 5 results,  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{R}$  speaking, singing, making music, giving thanks, and submitting. $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{I}$ The first four appear easy to accept. Only the fifth one,  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{R}$  submitting to each other $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{I}$  catches our attention.
