The Promise:

If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. (John 15:5)

In practice, I struggle with a "theology of distance." And I'm not the only one. There's something in us that feels like God watches us from a distance - if he's aware of us at all. We tend to think of God up there somewhere out of reach and out of touch with our lives.

world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment.
<small>9</small> The world's sin is that it
refuses to believe in me. <small>10</small> Righteousness is available because I
