SERIES REVIEW

Week One: We need the Holy Spirit to work in us, so we can experience the blessings of God's kingdom here and now. So, we prayed, "Draw us close, Holy Spirit. Captivate us. Set our eyes on our King Jesus. Overwhelm us with your presence."
