NEW TEACHING SERIES COMING IN NOVEMBER:

FIRST

Whatever holds first place in our lives matters deeply. When King Jesus is first, his Kingdom-Family grows in and through us.

Why dedicate an entire Sunday morning worship celebration to a prayer meeting?

We've talked about prayer skills and connecting with God for three weeks. Now it's time to practice those skills together.

We will focus on praying, and everything we do will be based on the Bible. We will pray silently. We will pray together.

You may pray on your knees or seated or standing. You may choose to pray here at the altar rail.

Revelation 5:1-8 NLT

<small>1</small> Then I saw a scroll in the right hand of the one who was sitting on the throne. There was writing on the inside and the outside of the scroll, and it was sealed with seven seals. <small>2</small> And I saw a strong angel, who shouted with a loud voice: $\hat{a} \in \omega$ Who is worthy to break the seals on this scroll and open it? $\hat{a} \in \omega$

color="#999999">3</small> But no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll and read it. <small>4</small> Then I began to weep bitterly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll and read it. <small>5</small> But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{Z}$ weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{Z}$ throne, has won the victory. Then I saw a Lamb that looked as if it had been slaughtered, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which represent the sevenfold Spirit of God that is sent out into every part of the earth. <small>7</small> He stepped forward and took the scroll from the right hand of the one sitting on the throne. <small>8</small> And when he took the scroll, the four living beings and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. <small>3</small> Then another angel with a
gold incense burner came and stood at the altar. And a great amount of
incense was given to him to mix with the prayers of $Godâe^{m}$ s people as an
offering on the gold altar before the throne. <small>4</small> The smoke of the incense, mixed with
the prayers of $Godâe^{m}$ s holy people, ascended up to God from the altar
where the angel had poured them out. <small>5</small> Then the angel filled the incense
burner with fire from the altar and threw it down upon the earth; and
thunder crashed, lightning flashed, and there was a terrible earthquake.
