Sermon in a Sentence:

If your view of Jesus is inadequate or inaccurate, then your view of who he wants you to become will be off target too.

Mark 1:1-13 NIV

<small>1</small> The beginning of the good news about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God, <small>2</small> as it is written in Isaiah the prophet: "I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way" – <small>3</small> "a voice of one calling in the wilderness, 'Prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him.' " <small>4</small> And so John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. <small>5</small> The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River. <small>6</small> John wore clothing made of camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. <small>7</small> And this was his message: "After me comes the one more powerful than I, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to stoop down and untie. <small>8</small> I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." <small>9</small> At that time Jesus came from Nazareth in Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. <small>10</small> Just as Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. <small>11</small> And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." <small>12</small> At once the Spirit sent him out into the wilderness, <small>13</small> and he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. He was with the wild animals, and angels attended him.
