Sermon in 4 Sentences:

Strong love has two sides. One side will never stop loving your child. The other side will do what's best for your child regardless of the cost. If you want to truly love your children, you must have both sides.

Pitting love against discipline is an incorrect division.

Your responsibility is to discipline your child in love and not out of fear or anger or some other selfish motive.

Your goal as a Jesus following parent is to guide your children into responsible adults who follow Jesus with you.

You are responsible to guide your kids. You are not responsible for their decisions.
