<small>1</small> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <small>2</small> He was with God in the beginning. <small>3</small> Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. <small><font</pre> color="#999999">4</small> In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind. small>5 light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. <small>6</small> There was a man sent from God whose name was John. <mall>7/small> He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. <mall>8 himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light. <small>9</small> The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. <small><font</pre> color="#999999">10</small> He was in the world, and though theworld was made through him, the world did not recognize him. <small>11</small> He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. <small>12</small> Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God- <small>13</small> children born not

We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth. <small>15</small> (John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the one I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.'") <small>16</small> Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. <small>17</small> For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. <small>18</small> No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.
