# Luke 2:21-38 NLT

<small><font color="#999999">21</font></small> Eight days later, when
the baby was circumcised, he was named Jesus, the name given him by the
angel even before he was conceived. <small><font
color="#999999">22</font></small> Then it was time for their
purification offering, as required by the law of Moses after the birth of

a child; so his parents took him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. <small><font color="#999999">23</font></small> The law of the Lord says, "If a woman's first child is a boy, he must be dedicated to the Lord ." <small><font color="#999999">24</font></small> So they offered the sacrifice required in the law of the Lord—"either a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons." <small><font color="#999999">25</font>/small> At that time there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon. He was righteous and devout and was eagerly waiting for the Messiah to come and rescue Israel. The Holy Spirit was upon him <small><font color="#999999">26</font></small> and had revealed to him that he would not die until he had seen the Lord's Messiah. <small><font color="#999999">27</font></small> That day the Spirit led him to the Temple. So when Mary and Joseph came to present the baby Jesus to the Lord as the law required, <small><font color="#999999">28</font> Simeon was there. He took the child in his arms and praised God, saying, <small><font color="#999999">29</font></small> "Sovereign Lord, now let your servant die in peace, as you have promised. <small><font color="#999999">30</font></small> I have seen your salvation, <small><font color="#999999">31</font></small> which you have prepared for all people. <small><font color="#999999">32</font></small> He is a light to reveal God to the nations, and he is the glory of your people Israel!" <small><font color="#999999">33</font></small> Jesus' parents were amazed at what was being said about him. <small><font color = "#999999" > 34 < /font > < /small > Then Simeon blessed them, and he saidto Mary, the baby's mother, "This child is destined to cause many in Israel to fall, and many others to rise. He has been sent as a sign from God, but many will oppose him. <small><font color="#999999">35</font></small> As a result, the deepest thoughts of many hearts will be revealed. And a sword will pierce your very soul." <small><font color="#999999">36</font></small> Anna, a prophet, was also there in the Temple. She was the daughter of Phanuel from the tribe of Asher, and she was very old. Her husband died when they had been married only seven years. <small><font color="#999999">37</font> she lived as a widow to the age of eighty-four. She never left the Temple but stayed there day and night, worshiping God with fasting and prayer. <small><font color="#999999">38</font></small> She came along just as Simeon was talking with Mary and Joseph, and she began praising God. She talked about the child to everyone who had been waiting expectantly for God to rescue Jerusalem.

brothers and sisters, that my situation has actually turned out to
advance the gospel: <small><font color="#999999">13</font></small> The
whole imperial guard and everyone else knows that I am in prison for the

sake of Christ, <small><font color="#999999">14</font></small> and most of the brothers and sisters, having confidence in the Lord because of my imprisonment, now more than ever dare to speak the word fearlessly. <small><font color="#999999">15</font></small> Some, to be sure, are preaching Christ from envy and rivalry, but others from goodwill. <small><font color="#999999">16</font></small> The latter do so from love because they know that I am placed here for the defense of the gospel. <small><font color="#999999">17</font></small> The former proclaim Christ from selfish ambition, not sincerely, because they think they can cause trouble for me in my imprisonment. <small><font</pre> color="#999999">18</font></small> What is the result? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is being proclaimed, and in this I rejoice. Yes, and I will continue to rejoice, <small><font color="#999999">19</font></small> for I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus

For he is my brother, coworker and fellow soldier, and your messenger and minister to me in my need. <small><font color="#999999">26</font></small> Indeed, he greatly missed all of you and was distressed because you heard that he had been ill. <small><font color="#999999">27</font></small> In fact he became so ill that he nearly died. But God showed mercy to him - and not to him only, but also to me - so that I would not have grief on top of grief. <small><font color="#999999">28</font></small> Therefore I am all the more eager to send him, so that when you see him again you can rejoice and I can be free from anxiety. <small><font</pre> color="#999999">29</font></small> So welcome him in the Lord with great joy, and honor people like him, <small><font color="#999999">30</font></small> since it was because of the work of Christ that he almost died. He risked his life so that he could make up for your inability to serve me.

### Sermon in a Sentence:

Whatever this is, Jesus is with me, and this is not the end of our story.

Because we seek comfortable and secure circumstances more than we pursue Jesus, we confuse joy with happiness. Allow me to draw a line to distinguish them from each other.

Happiness is a feeling we have in response to what happens to us. When what is happening is pleasant, comfortable, and secure, we feel happy. Joy is an action that the Holy Spirit living in us produces. The Spirit gives us the power to rejoice because of our relationship with Jesus. Rejoicing is an action we decide to do. Joy surpasses our situations. When we resolve to rejoice, joy replaces our powerlessness.

Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I say, rejoice!

How can we rejoice when our lives are out of control and we feel powerless?

Whatever the situation is, Jesus is with us, and this is not the end of our story.
