But love will last forever! <small>9</small> Now our knowledge is partial and incomplete, and even the gift of prophecy reveals only part of the whole picture! <small>10</small> But when the time of perfection comes, these partial things will become useless. <small><font</pre> color="#999999">11</small> When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things. <small>12</small> Now we see things imperfectly, like puzzling reflections in a mirror, but then we will see everything with perfect clarity. All that I know now is partial and incomplete, but then I will know everything completely, just as God now knows me completely. <small>13</small> Three things will last foreverâ \in "faith, hope, and loveâ \in "and the greatest of these is love.
