Text: Luke 6:27-36

If you compare your life to an orchard, what do you want to harvest from it?

The "Law of Planting and Harvesting"
What you plant, you harvest;
and almost always you harvest much more of it.

Luke 6:37-45 NET
37</small> "Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned; forgive, and you will be forgiven. 38</small> Give, and it will be given to you: A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be poured into your lap. For the measure you use will be the measure you receive." 39</small> He also told them a parable: "Someone who is blind cannot lead another who is blind, can he? Won't they both fall into a pit? 40</small> A disciple is not greater than his teacher, but everyone when fully trained will be like his teacher. 41</small> Why do you see the speck in your brother's eye, but fail to see the beam of wood in your own? 42</small> How can you say to your brother, "Brother, let me remove the speck from your eye," while you yourself don't see the beam in your own? You hypocrite! First remove the beam from your own eye, and then you can see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye. 43</small> "For no good tree bears bad fruit, nor again does a bad tree bear good fruit, 44</small> for each tree is known by its own fruit. For figs are not gathered from thorns, nor are grapes picked from brambles. 45</small> The good person out of the good treasury of his heart produces good, and the evil person out of his evil treasury produces evil, for his mouth speaks from what fills his heart. <https://bible.com/bible/107/luk.6.37-45>.NET

And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. <small>11</small> ““You fathersâ€”if your children ask for a fish, do you give them a snake instead? <small>12</small> Or if they ask for an egg, do you give them a scorpion? Of course not! <small>13</small> So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him.”
