Title: How Do You Know Me?

Hebrews 9:11-15 NLT

<small><font color="#999999">11</font></small> So Christ has now become
the High Priest over all the good things that have come. He has entered
that greater, more perfect Tabernacle in heaven, which was not made by
human hands and is not part of this created world. <small><font
color="#999999">12</font></small> With his own bloodâ€"not the blood of
goats and calvesâ€"he entered the Most Holy Place once for all time and
secured our redemption forever. <small><font
color="#999999">13</font></small> Under the old system, the blood of
goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer could cleanse peopleâ€<sup>™</sup>s bodies
from ceremonial impurity. <small><font color="#999999">14</font></small>
Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences
from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God. For by the power

of the eternal Spirit, Christ offered himself to God as a perfect sacrifice for our sins. <small><font color="#999999">15</font></small>
That is why he is the one who mediates a new covenant between God and people, so that all who are called can receive the eternal inheritance God has promised them.
