Sermon in a Sentence:

You can't steer a parked car and Jesus won't.

1. Listening: Attending to God, one another, and our neighborhoods

- 2. Discerning: Discovering where the Spirit is inviting us to join with God in our neighborhoods
- 3. Testing: Engaging simple actions to join with God in the neighborhood
- 4. Reflection: Gathering to ask, "What did we do? What are we learning? Where did we see God at work?"
- 5. Deciding: Determining what are the new ways we will now join with God in the neighborhood
