<small><font color="#999999">1</font></small> The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit. <small><font color="#999999">2</font></small> These were his instructions to them: "The harvest is great, but the workers are few. So pray to the Lord who is in charge of the harvest; ask him to send more workers into his fields. <small><font color="#999999">3</font></small> Now go, and remember that I am sending you out as lambs among wolves. <small><font color="#999999">4</font></small> Don't take any money with you, nor a traveler's bag, nor an extra pair of sandals.
